Whereas GE is a highly profitable multinational group, with its Power activities generating **1.1 billion dollars of operational profit** at Q3 2017...

Whereas the **6,000 job cuts** that followed the Alstom acquisition were said to be meant at redirecting GE Power towards sustainable business...

Whereas the Alstom/ General Electric deal was supposed to create a European energy giant **capable of investing in the development of Power activities...**

Whereas **the future of GE** lies in high-level investment in R&D, in workers' strategic know-how and in industrial assets to make the most of energy markets...

Whereas **Europe's energy production capacities and independence** rely heavily on a strong GE industrial base in Europe...
