Eight months after Alstom and Siemens Mobility announced their intention to merge, **the level of uncertainty remains unacceptably high!**

- What are Alstom and Siemens long-term strategies? Will they secure the viability and growth of the two companies?
- If the merger proceeds, what would the consequences on jobs, on all European workers and on their families be? What about the future of the railway supply industry in Europe?

Together, we urge Alstom and Siemens management to:

- Secure all jobs and all European sites, by opening negotiations with trade unions in all countries
- Secure the innovation capacities through ground-breaking R&D, ambitious investment plans and development of workers' skills
- Provide full clarity on Alstom and Siemens long-term industrial projects
- Commit to high-level standards of social dialogue and to respect workers' rights to information, consultation and participation on the envisaged merger

European policy-makers have a responsibility too. We urge them to swiftly deliver a strong industrial policy to support the railway supply industry in Europe.
