Steel production in Europe (EU) has **reduced by 40%** and new orders have been **cut by 70-75%**.



It is estimated that at least 45% of the workforce are subjected to temporary layoffs and reduced working.



There are genuine fears that around **50% of steelmaking capacity could be lost** by the end of this pandemic.



While Europe has been suffering, **China** managed to increase their production by **1,3%** in the first quarter of 2020.
