Introduction of SZREDA (BG)

- Non-governmental, non-political organisation, governed by Public Law
- Founded in 1995, pre-registered in 1997

The Agency was established in 1995 by Stara Zagora Municipality with the support of the US Agency for International Development (USAID). Initially serving as a liaison focused on strengthening communication between city governments and the business community. Nowadays its members are all 11 municipalities in the Region, Trakia University, Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Bulgarian-German VET.





OBJECTIVE

De Carb brings together 9 partners (9 countries), to exchange experiences & transfer knowledge on how to transition from the carbon-intensive era towards the clean energy future. It will support regions to secure sustainable development, economic & societal stability, and a role in the 2030 energy mix.


MAIN OUTPUTS & BENEFICIARIES
