About the internship

The successful candidate will support industriAll Europe's work on Building Trade Union Power (BTUP), helping trade unions across Europe strengthen organising, recruitment, retention and workplace activism.

The internship combines organising and campaigning work with communication activities. The intern will work closely with both the Strategic Organising and Communication teams and contribute to showcasing trade union successes, campaigns and organising experiences across Europe.

Key tasks may include

- Supporting European organising and trade union renewal projects and campaigns.
- Assisting in the preparation of workshops, conferences, training activities and international meetings.
- Drafting articles, reports, presentations and communication materials.
- Supporting social media activities and helping communicate organising successes and campaign outcomes.
- Assisting in the production of videos, interviews, testimonials and other communication content.
- Supporting contacts with affiliates and project partners across Europe.
- Providing general organisational and administrative support for BTUP activities.

- A student in the final stage of a BA, MA or equivalent programme, with an internship as part of their studies.
- Strong interest in trade unions, labour rights, social movements, organising, campaigning or workers' participation.
- Excellent command of English (written and spoken).
- Good writing, communication and organisational skills.
- Interest in digital communication, social media and storytelling.
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in an international environment.
- Knowledge of other European languages is an advantage.
- Experience with trade unions, NGOs, student organisations, campaigning or communication activities is an asset.
